A MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR, SHERIDAN SNELL & OUR PRESIDENT & CEO, MAGGI FEINER

Dear Friends of FISH,

2019 proved to be a kinder year for our environment than we've seen recently—our water remained clean and storms spared southwest Florida. Following two years of natural disasters, the reprieve for our islands was, and is, welcome.

Logic would tell you that change for the better would translate to a reduction in service requests for FISH but in fact, we continue to grow. As awareness has grown, in large part due to the role FISH has played in assisting in these disasters, we have seen more islanders requesting assistance they need but didn't know existed.

In 2019 our community was able to assist clients in the following ways:

- *20,885 service requests were answered on behalf of 5,544 individuals*
- *8,364 visits to our food pantry resulted in 247,903 pounds of food distributed*
- *332 instances of emergency financial assistance, and 2,502 meetings with our Social Services Department*
- *399 Neighbors attended our Friendly Faces luncheon*
- *Volunteers drove islanders to 197 appointments on and off-island*
- *Through our Youth Programs 142 instances of after school/summer programming were attended, 1,160 food backpacks were distributed, and 151 children received school supplies*

It truly takes a village and thanks to all of our donors, volunteers, and community partners we continue to keep pace with our growth to meet the needs of our neighbors. Since 1982 these islands have worked to take care of each other through good times and bad, and we are humbled and grateful for the opportunity to continue to serve.

FISH FOOD PROGRAMS

FIGHTING FOOD INSECURITY

People are often surprised to hear that the island communities are home to a food pantry. They are often more surprised to hear how often the pantry is utilized. No community is immune to food insecurity, and at FISH we work daily to ensure that no islander is deciding between feeding their family or paying rent, childcare, or medical bills. FISH combats this issue through our various food programs thanks to our generous donors, volunteers, community partners, and staff.

here's a look at how we helped our neighbors in 2019

FOOD PANTRY

Last year *FISH distributed 247,903 pounds of food through 8,364 visits to our food pantry, and 1,169 families were served equating to 206,586 meals.* FISH offers nutritious supplemental groceries at our Walk-in Center to our island neighbors five days a week from 10:00am-3:45pm, allowing our clients to shop according to their own life schedules that may otherwise prevent them from getting the resources they need.

MEALS-BY-FISH

Our Meals-by-FISH program ensures that all islanders, regardless of mobility constraints, have access to at least one hot meal per day, and fresh meals seven days a week. Whether it's an island senior who no longer cooks or drives or a resident who temporarily can use the assistance, *our volunteers delivered 3,260 meals in 2019.*





BACKPACK PROGRAM

Nutrition is fundamental to academic achievement. *Students received 1,160 backpacks full of nutritious foods and snacks* to sustain them over weekends and school breaks, when they don't have school-provided meals.

HOLIDAY FOOD BASKETS

Guaranteeing a holiday meal to our island neighbors in need is both a warm way for our community to give back during the holiday seasons, but also relieves families of the stress of providing it during what can be a financially strained time. Last year, *188 households received baskets with all the fixings for Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas meals.*

LENDING A HAND

WHEN IT'S NEEDED MOST

Imagine just a few short months after getting back on your feet following the water quality crisis, being diagnosed with advanced stage cancer with two children at home under the age of five. Your treatment keeps you from working for months preventing you from paying rent and keeping up with medical bills.

EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

This scenario was the case for FISH client, Michelle, but sadly is not an unusual circumstance for many of the clients we serve. The key to navigating any crisis is having support and a plan. *Through our Helping Hands program, FISH offers both.*

Our Social Services Department responded to over 2,500 instances of case management in order to offer clients in crisis help with essential costs such as rent, utilities, and medical bills through our Emergency Financial Assistance program. One of the greatest gifts we can give neighbors-in-need is the time to create and implement a plan to move them from crisis to recovery, and eventually develop a pathway to long-term self-sustainability alongside our professional staff, with the support of our volunteers, community partners, and supporters.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

WITH SOCIAL AND SENIOR SERVICES

FISH is keenly focused on issues pertaining to the senior population on the islands, including isolation and loneliness. Through a variety of programs, it is our goal to be there for islanders as they age to remain healthy, independent, engaged, and age in place with dignity.

FRIENDLY FACES LUNCHEON

These popular (and fun!) lunches are held once a month at George and Wendy's Seafood Grille with a theme, games, prizes and plenty of opportunity for socialization. Cost is subsidized by FISH and in some cases covered entirely when there is financial need. We encourage all community members to come, meet new people and enjoy a delicious meal! Rides to and from are available with advance notice by one of our volunteer drivers. *We saw 399 Friendly Faces at lunch in 2019.*

NON-EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION

Individuals needing transportation for on-island errands (such as non-emergent medical, dental, church, shopping, banking) or off-island medical appointments can request a FISH volunteer driver. Rides are free of charge. *In 2019, our volunteers drove neighbors to nearly 200 appointments.*

WORKSHOPS

FISH is pleased to enlist a variety of professionals to come to the islands to speak on topics important to everyone. Our informative workshops last year pertaining to aging included one-on-one Medicare consultations, the dementia virtual tour, healthy eating, mental wellness, and a variety of other health and wellness issues.

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT LOAN PROGRAM

Islanders and visitors alike may borrow much-needed medical equipment free of charge such as wheelchairs, walkers, canes, and bath benches. *FISH loaned 325 pieces of equipment to our neighbors in 2019.*

We strive to provide "extras" to all students in the form of safe and enriching programs outside of school. *In 2019, we provided 142 of those educational opportunities.*

We're never too old or too smart to learn something new. Educational opportunities are offered for our entire community and include FISH's monthly workshops on topics ranging from mental health, financial management, and the aging process to hands-on classes like cooking and nutrition.

ANALYSIS OF FUNDING & EXPENDITURES

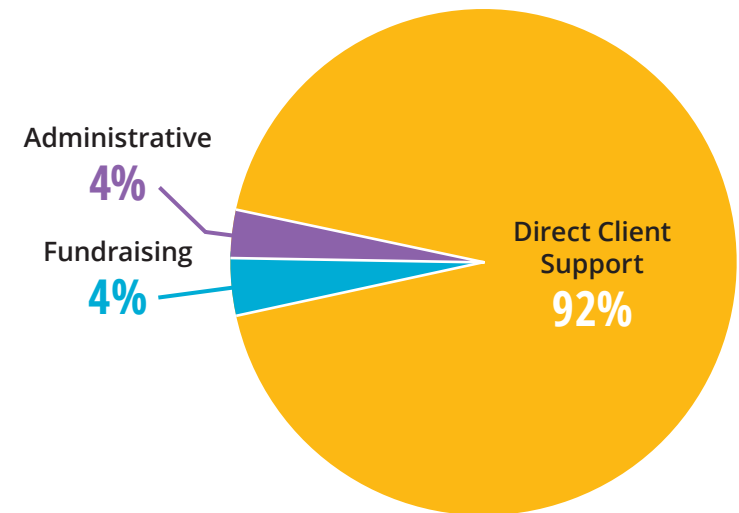

WHAT IS PLANNED GIVING?

“Planned giving” is simply a commitment, either revocable or irrevocable, to give to a Section 501(c)(3) charity, such as FISH or its Foundation, as part of a donor’s overall financial or estate planning (as contrasted with typical annual donations).

TYPES OF PLANNED GIFTS

- 1 **Bequests**—donations at death (through a Will or Trust) of cash, real estate, stocks, bonds, mutual funds, or other intangible assets
- 2 **Retirement Plans**—designation of FISH as a beneficiary of a retirement account, such as an IRA, 401(k), 403(b), pension or profit sharing plan
- 3 **Life Insurance**—designation of FISH as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy (whole life or term)
- 4 **Retained Life Estate**—transfer of real estate, such as a residence or commercial property, to FISH, but with the donor retaining the use of the property for the remainder of the donor’s lifetime (e.g., the Woodring property)

WITH A PLANNED GIFT, A DONOR MAY

- *Create an endowment to generate annual income that provides for the development and enhancement of designated FISH programs and activities (e.g., Helping Hands or the Food Pantry)*
- *Create an endowment to enhance FISH staff development or subsidize the compensation for a specific position, similar to endowing a professorship at a university*
- *Name the FISH Walk-In Center (or an office) for the donor or in honor/memory of a loved one or another person*
