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About this Report

F.I.S.H. of SANCAP conducted a CASOA™ survey across the Sanibel and Captiva communities. Survey invitations were mailed to all 2,895 known households with an adult 55 years or older and data were collected from March 26th, 2021 to May 14, 2021. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to the open participation survey was publicized by F.I.S.H. of SANCAP. The open participation survey was identical to the main survey effort and open to all residents of Sanibel and Captiva age 55 or older. The survey became available on April 20th and remained open for three weeks. There were 33 responses to the open participation survey.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the respondents cannot be estimated. Due to limited response, the results were not statistically weighted. No adjustments were made for design effects.
